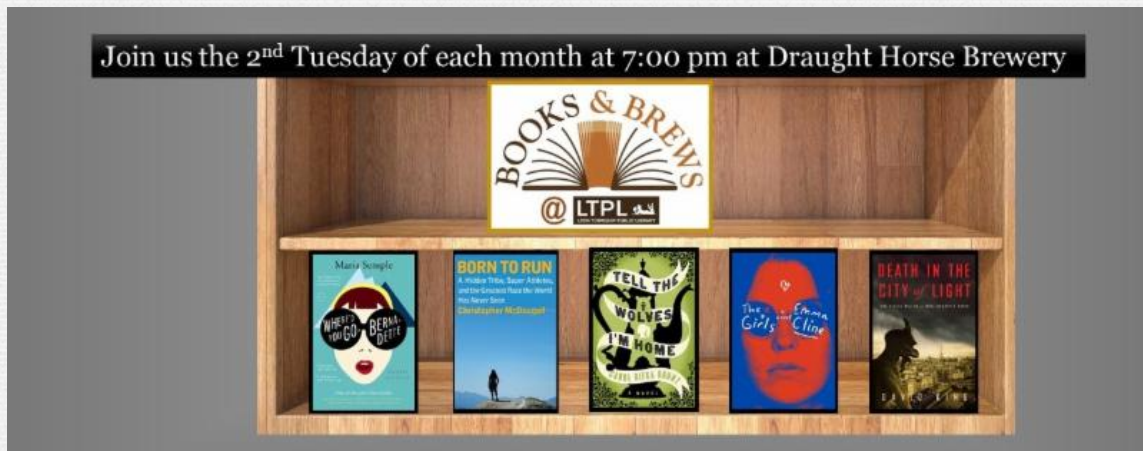
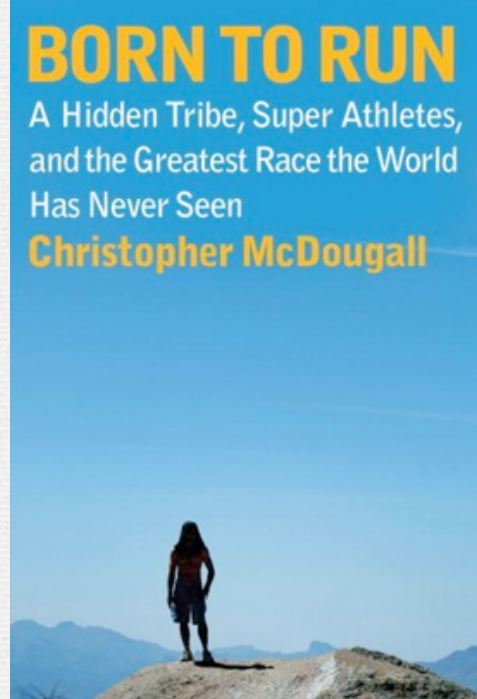
We are happy to present this year's Community Read book
