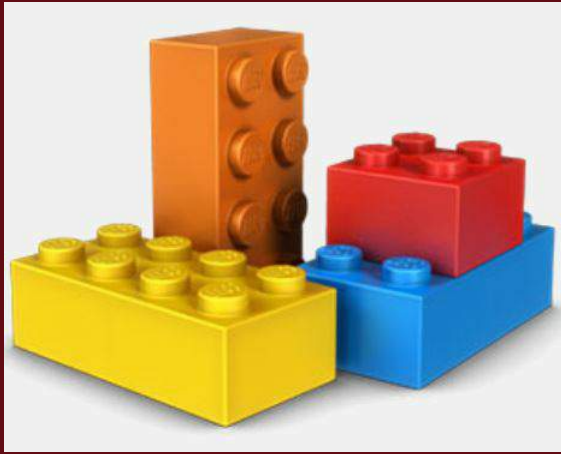

All ages are welcome!



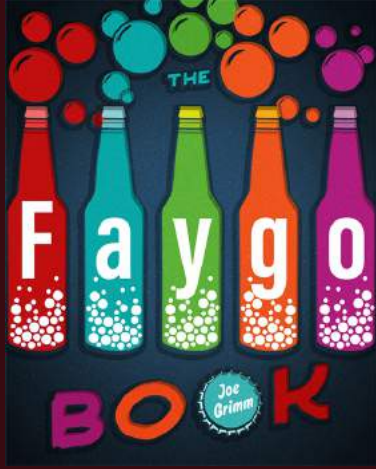
Tech Take Apart

Friday, September 27, 2:00-3:30PM

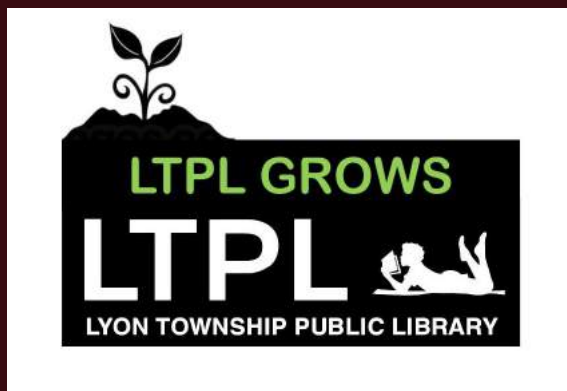
All are welcome to come share their ideas, show genealogy treasures or tell us about a brick wall that they have encountered. We all have a lot of experiences to share with each other!

Monday, September 16, 6:30-8:30PM

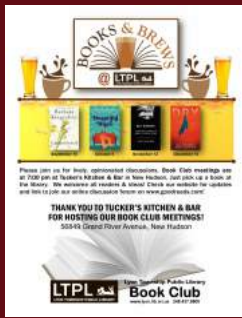
