April 23, 1:00 pm

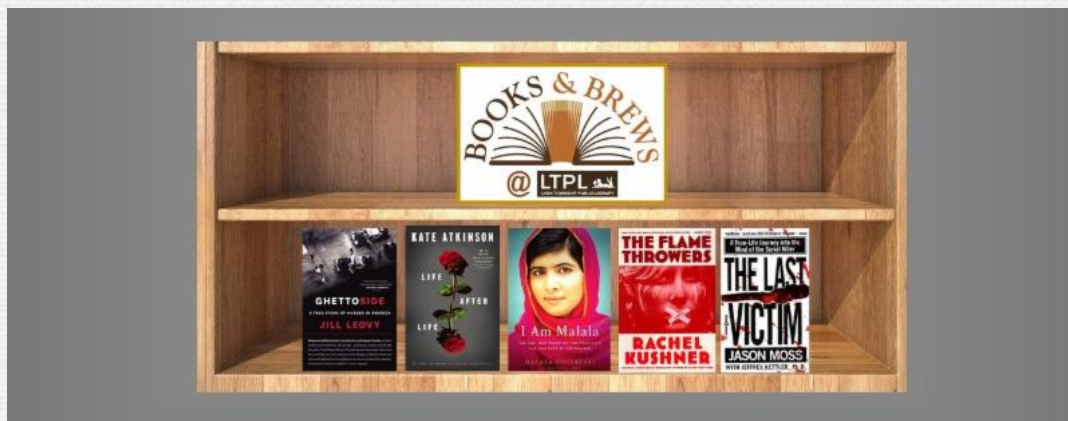
Presented by John Blair and Therese McCarthy
