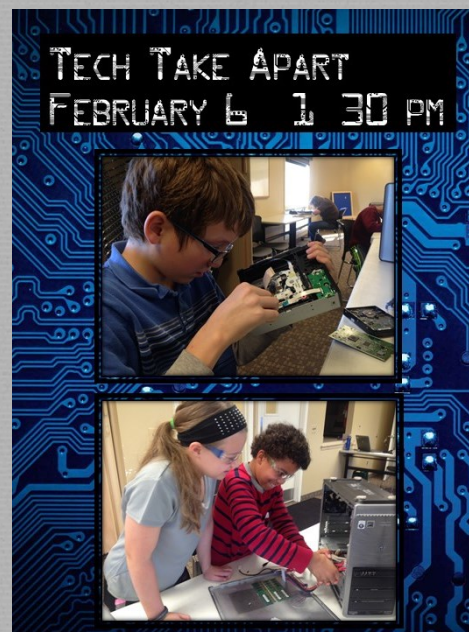
Community Recycling Event & Tech Take Apart

Students 4th grade and up are welcome to join us as we take apart computers and electronic devices to figure out how they work.

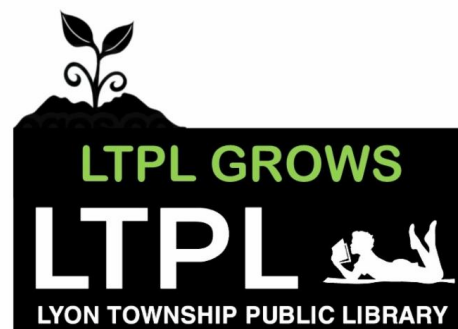

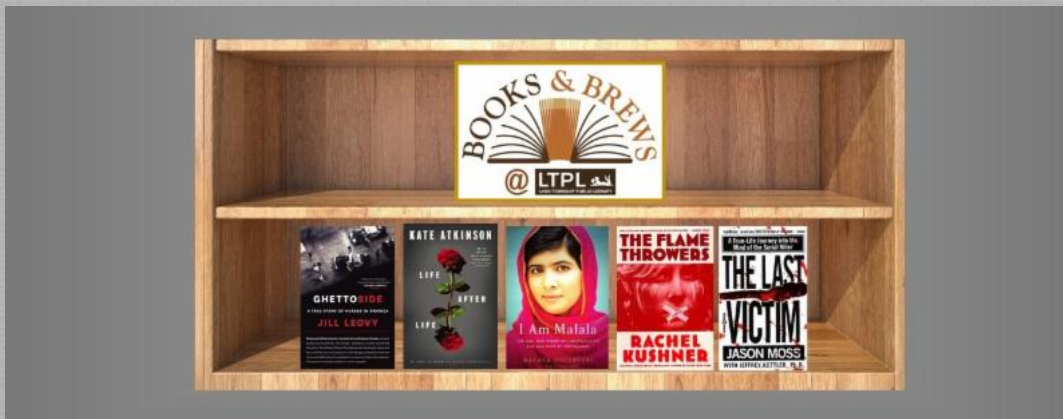
Seed Starting Workshop February 22, 6:30 pm
